

We connect policymakers to a global network of 60+ energy experts for personalized and responsive technical assistance on **strategies, regulations, standards, financial incentives, and deployment programs** for a broad range of clean energy sectors and technologies:

Policy Support Levels

Various levels of support provided:

- Short turn-around support of 1-20 hours (10%)
- Higher level assistance of 20-40 hours (70%)
- More in depth support of over 40 to 120 hours (20%)
 - Potential opportunity to provide on-site support in country locations
 - On-site workshops where large number of policymakers are convened, including side events at conferences and events

Examples of High-Impact Policy Requests



▪ Montserrat

- Assisted with development of clean energy awareness campaign for consumers



▪ South Africa

- Supported strategy to establish a net feed in tariff (NETFIT) policy for South Africa, stimulating market for small-scale generation



▪ Economic Community Of West African States (ECOWAS)

- Assisted with regional policy to mainstream gender into energy access with policy adopted at Ministerial level December 2016
- Supported development of regional renewable fuels standards
- Developed clean cookstove national action plans for 12 countries



▪ Mauritius

- Authored chapter on gender mainstreaming for Mauritius's Long-term Energy Strategy for the Ministry of Energy and Public Utilities



Requests by Sector


Sector Distribution by Percentage

Partnering on Regional & National Training Events


- **APEC:** Training on clean energy policies and measures for the public sector to drive private investment

Webinars


- Substantially increased the number of training webinars provided through the resource library and through Solutions Center YouTube channel.
