Background

- APEC has set a collective goal of doubling its share of renewables in its energy mix by 2030 relative to 2010 and supporting the global goal of tripling renewables by 2030.
- Given these aspirations, the policy capabilities of APEC members needs to be strengthened to promote the formulation of policies for **new** and renewable energy supply. This will help APEC economies meet their respective targets and pathways.
- This will be facilitated by a capacity building workshop focusing on developing new and renewable energy related policies.
 - The workshop will be held in conjunction with the first EGNRET meeting in 2026 (assuming all relevant conditions are met).

To achieve this, the project aims to: Identifying common challenges in implementing new and renewable energy related policies of the member economies; Sharing best practices of the selected case; and Proposing new ideas to improve the existing or, in case of the absence of any, develop, new and renewable energy policies of the member economies.
