EGEEC60 Meeting

- The EGEEC60 meeting was hosted by Hong Kong, China from 15 to 16 March 2023 in hybrid mode.
- Meeting Theme was "Accelerating Energy Efficiency Enhancement through Technological Innovations".
- One-day Technical Visit was organised by Hong Kong, China on 17 March 2023.





EGEEC Governance Issues

- The selection of EGEEC Chair and Vice Chair was held at the EGEEC 60 meeting and the results were endorsed by members.
- Members reached a consensus to select the following candidates as the EGEEC
 Chair and Vice-chair for the tenure from 1 July 2023 to 30 June 2025.
 - EGEEC Chair: Dr Liu Meng China
 - > EGEEC Vice-chair: Ms Jovian Cheung Hong Kong, China
- Members agreed to invite the World Green Building Council as our guest member.

3-year Guest Status in EGEEC - World Green Building Council (WorldGBC) WORLD GREEN BUILDING COUNCIL

- WorldGBC is a non-profit organisation and global network of national Green Building Councils (GBCs).
- The organisation is committed to achieving the following goals by 2050:
 - limiting global temperature rises to 2 degrees Celsius;
 - reducing the building and construction sector's carbon emissions by 84 gigatonnes;
 - ensuring all buildings have net zero emissions.
- These goals will ensure the buildings and construction sector plays its part in delivering on the ambition of the Paris Agreement.
- EGEEC and WorldGBC share the same goal of reducing building energy consumption, which accounts for over 30% of global energy consumption.
- Nowadays, 17 of the 21 APEC economies are either established members, affiliate partners or prospective members of WorldGBC.
- The APEC Guest Status will allow us to join hands together to share knowledge and experience through our collaboration with WorldGBC.
