EGNRET 43 Summary



- Role of EGNRET Toward the Doubling Renewable Energy Goal in APEC Region
- The discussion was mainly focused on issues:
 - Total Primary Energy Supply (TPES) or Total Final Energy Consumption (TFEC) is possible for the calculation, depend on the major concern in promoting renewable energy.
 - Monitor system and report mechanism will be the important issues in future
 - Financial mechanism is needed for private sector to make the contribution to the implementation of renewable energy.
 - Discussion about Hydrogen and Hydros definition
 - EGNRET will encourage the proposal based on the identified priority in order to remove the barrier and speed up the implementation of renewable energy.

EWG 48 Summary



- Report from APEC Secretariat by Mr. Jonghan Park, EWG Program Director at the APEC Secretariat
 - 44 of 99 concept notes were approved last year with an average cost of \$150K per project.
 - To redirect unused sub-fund to the General Fund (TBC). It may impact the Energy Efficiency Sub-Fund.

EWG 48 - Goal for Doubling RE



- EGNRET highlighted challenges towards the goal of doubling renewable energy – definition and calculation
- <u>EWG has defined the renewable energy should exclude</u> traditional biomass and include the standard large hydro.
- Discussion of the share calculations should be based on primary energy or energy consumption.
 - should identify the best practices and make the practices available cross the economies. This will be the key to remove barriers to renewable energy and address poverty.
- EGNRET will continue to work with EGEDA, EGEEC, and APERC within APEC, and will reach out to IRENA, IEA and ASEAN to make further progress on this effort.

Asia Pacific Economic Cooperation - Energy Working Group APEC Strategic Plan for 2014 - 2018

Develop Cleaner Energy Sources:

Page 10

- Support the UN Secretary General's SE4ALL initiative by endeavoring to double the share of renewables from 2010 levels in the APEC energy mix, including in power generation, by 2030 and increasing the number and type of renewable energy projects.
- Conduct renewable energy resource assessments to facilitate a thorough understanding of renewable energy resource availability in APEC Member Economies.
- Engage in clean energy technology assessment and related activities to demonstrate the cost-effectiveness of clean energy applications.
- Facilitate improved reliability and stability in the provision of clean energy supply to meet demand.

EWG Proposed Work Plan for 2015

- The EWG plans to accelerate efforts on renewable energy to help meet the new aspirational goal endorsed by the Leaders' in 2014 to double the share of renewable energy in APEC's energy mix by 2030.
- The EWG is developing projects and activities to promote innovation, reduce costs and improve sustainability of renewable energy to support this goal for the APEC region as a whole.
- Specific activities may include capacity building for equipment installers and auditors, helping policymakers set renewable targets and reach their goals, improving data gathering such as resource mapping, conducting a Peer Review on Low Carbon Energy Policies (PRLCE), and other areas to share lessons learned and develop best practices.
- The EWG will seek collaboration with international partners such as the International Renewable Energy Agency (IRENA) and ASEAN to implement a set of new projects.


